CONDITIONS:

Please note that you are required to be proficient in English or German at level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ programme as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that of (900.00€/ month). Each selected participant will also get a travel contribution of 1,735.00€. Summer term 2026 at HNEE starts on the **16th of March 2026 and ends on the 31st of July 2026**. It is expected of all students to arrive at least a week before the start of the term.

APPLICATION:

If you wish to participate in the Erasmus+ exchange, first you need to apply directly at the International Office at Thai Nguyen University of Agriculture and Forestry. In case you are selected and pre-nominated by your home university, you will receive further information about the application process from HNEE. Make sure you apply with the following documents:

- **Motivational letter** for the chosen study programme
- **Current enrolment certificate** from your University
- **Transcript of records**
- **Language certificate** (CERF English B2)

An application only has a chance of being successful if the documents are submitted altogether and in complete form. All language certificates must comply with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Otherwise, your application cannot be taken into consideration
